Put Fats, Oils and Grease in the Trash, Not Your Drain

Did you know you shouldn't put fats, oils and grease (F.O.G.) down the drain? Improper disposal of these items can lead to drain damage, sewer backups and expensive repairs. Running hot water down the drain won't keep F.O.G. from sticking to your pipes. Don't pour any greasy food or oils down the garbage disposal, toilet or any other drain. This includes all meat fats, lard, cooking oil, sauces, butter, and margarine. After cooking, let these items cool and dispose of them in the trash instead.
