

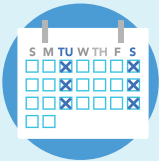
SAVING WATER IS THE LONG BEACH WAY

Do Your Part, Limit Outdoor Watering

We're proud our Long Beach community has embraced the water-wise lifestyle. But as we face unprecedented drought across California, we all need to do more.

Green lawns and gushing sprinklers are the biggest source of water waste in our community. To cut down on our use, the Long Beach Board of Water Commissioners has declared a Stage 2 water shortage, restricting outdoor watering to two days a week.

New Outdoor Watering Rules:



Water your yard **ONLY** on Tuesdays and Saturdays



ONLY water before 9 a.m. or after 4 p.m.



Limit watering to **10 minutes per station**, or **20 minutes total for rotating nozzles**

Every drop counts – if we all work together, small water-saving habits can make a big difference in ensuring we have enough water now and in the future.
